Boil Water Advisory Issued for Town of Kingsville

Dr. Mehdi Aloosh, Medical Officer of Health, has issued a Boil Water Advisory for Town of Kingsville serviced by Union Water Supply specifically:



The reason for the boil water advisory is due to loss of pressure.

The Windsor-Essex County Health Unit is strongly recommending that only bottled water, or water brought to a hard boil for one (1) minute should be used for consumption, infant feeding, or food and ice preparation. The precautionary boil water advisory will remain in effect until further notice, following corrective actions taken by Union Water Supply System. There have been no illnesses reported to date.
